What You Heard *In the Word*

2. What kinds of bad things happened to Job?
Servants and children killed; oxen, donkeys, and camels stolen; fire from the sky killed the sheep; Job had sores all over.
3. What did Job do when these things happened?
He prayed and worshipped God.

2. God promised that someone from Abram's family would be a blessing to all families. Who was that? *Jesus.*
3. What does it mean to have faith in someone?
To trust him. Trust he will do what he says.

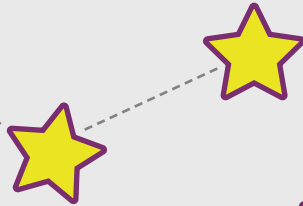

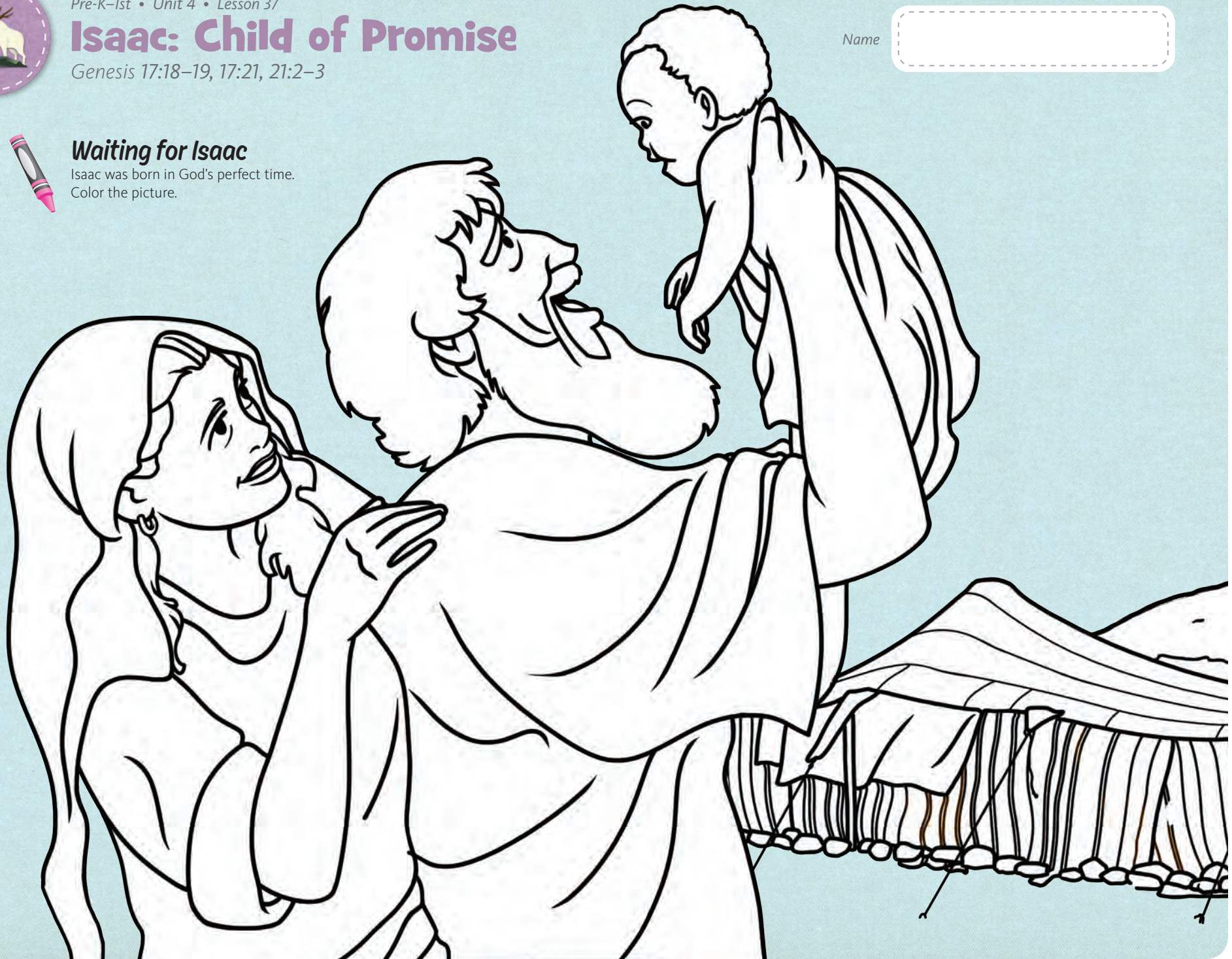

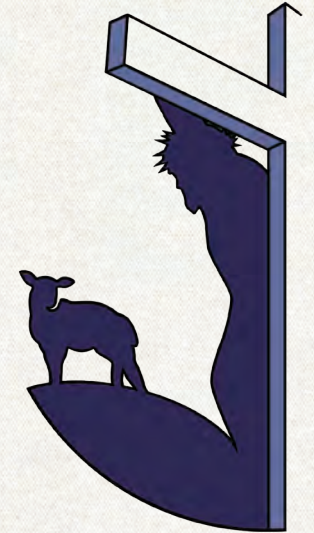
